




How much did the instructor motivate you to do your best work?






How much did the instructor emphasize student learning and development?

In a typical week, about how much time did you devote to this course? (Do not count scheduled class time, labs, etc.)







He was very rude and disrespectful at times. He would call people out in front of everyone which made students uncomfortable. If you asked a question, he did not answer in a polite manner. Often times, I would only raise my hand when he was turned the other way for fear that he would make me feel stupid if he was the one to answer my questions. It almost seemed like he was trying too hard to be the "cool" instructor and, to me, it came off as inappropriate. He did not inspire me to do my best work. Instead, he made me doubt myself and the way that I was learning. He also made the testing environment very anxious due to the things he would say before exams.

At times he may have been condenscending, but that may have just been because he knew a lot of information and he was trying to get me to say it but I just had no idea what the answer was.

At times he was a little bit abrupt or disrespectful with students. Also at the beginning of the semester he had people write down if they had disability accommodations on a note card and then called by name the students who said they did to come up to the front to discuss them. He did not allow them to have their confidentiality to a certain degree.

Nothing to complain about.

Most condescending instructor I've had. He likes talking AT us rather than WITH us. A lot of times he wouldn't repeat himself at the donor when someone didn't understand and made them wait until the end to ask again, rather than simply repeating himself real quick. I once asked him a question about the donor and he talked down to me rather than just helping me and made me feel horrible for asking him to clarify something, even though I never missed a lab and was a diligent student. I was so embarrassed and upset that I didn't ask him a question for the remainder of the semester.

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I understand that the test days are stressful, but sometimes his tone/wording made students more unnecessarily nervous.

I didn't really like how Theo seemed impatient most of the time when it came to helping students outside of the lecture and donor time and there was one incident in the classroom with a student that made surrounding students pretty uncomfortable. If there is any type of conflict in the classroom between a student and an AI it should be handled outside of the classroom, not in it for everyone to see. It was a very embarrassing situation for the student.
